BACKGROUND

- (i) In February 1947, The British Govt. declared that Britain will give Govt. of India to the Indian before June 1948.
- (ii) Viceroy Lord Wavell was replaced by Lord Louis Mountbatten. He tried to keep India united in which he failed.
- (iii)He met with all political leaders and sent his proposal to the British Govt. for approval.

Main points of 3rd June Plan

- i) Provinces of Punjab and Bangal would be divided through Boundary Commission.
- ii) Sindh Assembly would decide in a special session to join India or Pakistan.
- iii) The future of North West Frontier Province and District Sylhet of Asaam (Bangal) would be decided through referendum.
- iv) Quetta municipality and Shahi Jirga will decide the future of Balochistan.

- (v) All the Hindu Majority provinces i.e U.P, C.P, Bihar, Orrisa and Bombay would be included in India.
- (vi) There were 635 States which were ruled by Nawabs or Rajas. They were given option to decide their future and join the country of their own choice seeing following:-
- i) Geographical location may not be ignored.
- ii) Decision of accession should be according to the will of people.

Conclusion:

- i) A meeting of the Muslim League was held in Delhi on 10th June 1947, though Muslim league was not in favour of division of Punjab and Bangal wherein 3rd June plan was accepted as a whole for the sake of transfer of power.
- ii)The Indian National Congress Session was held on 14th June 1947 but this was told that "Geography, Mountain and the sea determine India. No human power can change it. Congress Committee believe that when the current hatred would diminish, then the Indian dispute will be seen in its true picture. This resolution reveals that Congress accepted Indian Partition plan.
