PARTITION OF INDIA

- i) According to 3rd June 1947 plan, the provinces of Punjab and Bangal were decided to be divided through boundary commission.
- ii) Constituent Assembly of Sindh, Shahi Jirga of Balochistan and people of NWFP and sylhet decided to join Pakistan.

- iii) A British lawyer, sir Cyril RadCliff was appointed as chairman to demarcate boundaries.
- iv) British Cabinet approved Independence Act on 18.07.1947.
- v) Muslims were in minority in the states of Junagarh, Manawadar, Hyderabbad Daccan. However, the state of Jammu & Kashmir was Muslim majority State.

ESTABLISHMENT OF PAKISTAN

- i) Quaid-e-Azam came to Karachi on 7th August 1947.
- ii) He was elected as president of first constituent Assembly on 11th August 1947.
- iii)Lord Mountbatten addressed to legislative Assembly and Pakistan came into being on 14th August 1947.
- iv)Quaid e Azam was appointed as First Governor General.
