# PARTITION OF INDIA

- i) According to 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1947 plan, the provinces of Punjab and Bangal were decided to be divided through boundary commission.
- ii) Constituent Assembly of Sindh, Shahi Jirga of Balochistan and people of NWFP and sylhet decided to join Pakistan.

iii) A British lawyer, sir Cyril RadCliff was appointed as chairman to demarcate boundaries.

iv) British Cabinet approved Independence Act on 18.07.1947.

v) Muslims were in minority in the states of Junagarh, Manawadar, Hyderabad Daccan. However, the state of Jammu & Kashmir was Muslim majority State.

# ESTABLISHMENT OF PAKISTAN

- i) Quaid-e-Azam came to Karachi on 7<sup>th</sup> August 1947.
- ii) He was elected as president of first constituent Assembly on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1947.
- iii) Lord Mountbatten addressed to legislative Assembly and Pakistan came into being on 14<sup>th</sup> August 1947.
- iv) Quaid e Azam was appointed as First Governor General.
